

DRAGONS WUNDERLICH SPARKS CICL WIN

July 21st, 2008 – Huntington, IN - The CICL defeated the KIT League 7-6 in the second all-star game ever played between the leagues in Huntingburg, Indiana, this evening.

DuPage Dragons Phil Wunderlich led the way for the CICL getting 3 hits and 3 RBI including a double and a homer. Danville's Andrew Pollak had 2 hits and an RBI and Springfield's Chris Gacom had a double and 2 RBI.

Ten CICL pitchers made an appearance. Springfield's Bryce Butt was credited with the victory and Danville's Tyler Hess earned the save.

For the KIT League, Justin Miller had a homer and 2 RBI and Kevin O'Hair had 2 RBI on a hit. Louis Haseltine and Ace Williams each had 2 hits. The KIT outhit the CICL 13-8 but made 3 errors leading to 2 unearned runs.

The CICL took the lead 7-6 in the bottom of the 6th on an RBI sacrifice fly by Wunderlich, which closed out the scoring.

The Dragons will return game to take on the league leading Springfield Sliders at 7:05pm. The Dragons currently with a second- half record of 5 wins and 5 losses, which is good for third in the CICL. Overall on the season, the Dragons have a cumulative record of 18-16 and sit 8.5 games behind league leading Springfield.
