Adam Davis (Driscoll Catholic, Bloomingdale, IL) earned All-Area and All-State accolades by the Chicago Tribune, Chicago Sun-Times, and Daily Herald in 2007, along with being named Suburban Catholic Player of the Year in 2008. His four varsity letters, second team All-State selection (All-State for 1A/2A), and ranking as the 15<sup>th</sup> best prospect in the state of Illinois are nothing to hide under the dirt as well. He has made the most of his limited opportunities, however, batting .500 as a pinch hitter.
