With a score of 10-3 in the bottom of the eighth inning, the Dans were not able to put any runs on the board, setting up the ninth inning with the score still 10-3.

Sean Flanagan moved from left field to pitcher in the ninth inning, looking very impressive, in his second pitching appearance of the season, closing out the game for a final score of 10-3.
